Alameda County Age-Friendly Planning

- ▶ Focus on unincorporated areas
 - ▶ Unincorporated areas under purview of County
 - ▶ “Civic infrastructure deserts” -- no governing board
 - ▶ Various cities completed (or in process of completing) their own citywide Age-Friendly Plan - Berkeley, Emeryville, Fremont, Oakland
- ▶ Plan priority areas:
 - ▶ Digital divide/literacy
 - ▶ Housing
 - ▶ Dementia Services
 - ▶ Disaster Planning
 - ▶ Outdoor spaces/transportation
 - ▶ Respect & social inclusion
 - ▶ Community & health services

Age-Friendly Plan Development Process

Mid-May 2021:
Acquired Age-Friendly Plan Development intern

September 2021: Meeting with unincorporated area community partners to discuss community input process

November 2021: Distribution of community survey; incorporate feedback in Age-Friendly Plan

January 2022: submission of draft Age-Friendly Plan to Board of Supervisors

June-August 2021: Countywide survey analysis; identification of themes

October 2021: Draft of Age-Friendly Plan completed, & distributed for feedback; revised community survey

December 2021: Incorporate community survey input into Plan
